Alpine Skiing and Snowboarding

Rules



General rules:

- 1. To participate in the competition:
 - a. complete the registration form with disclaimer.
 - b. pickup the bib number (refundable deposit \$20)
 - c. pay the appropriate registration fee
- 2. Submitting the entry to the competition is tantamount to accepting the rules of the competition.
- 3. The fee for the ski lifts is not included in the registration fee.
- 4. Each competition participant must wear a ski helmet and the starting bib number.

Classification:

- 1. Principles of division into groups:
 - a. Snowboarders one group regardless of age and gender.
 - b. Skiers age groups, according to the age reached on the day of the competition.
 - i. Girls 6-8, 9-11, 12-14
 - ii. Boys 6-8, 9-11, 12-14
 - iii. Women 15-24, 25-34, 35-44, 45+
 - iv. Men 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65+
- 2. During the descent, children may be assisted by their guardians (not crossing the finish line).
- 3. Participants start according to the Start Lists.
- 4. A person late for the start, starts at the end of the currently starting group.
- 5. The classification is based on the sum of the times obtained in two correct passes of all gates on the course, including the start and finish.
- 6. A gate has been passed correctly when both the competitor's ski tips and both feet have crossed the gate line. If a competitor loses a ski, without committing a fault, e.g. not by straddling a pole, then the tip of the remaining ski and both feet must have crossed the gate line.
- 7. In the Family Cup competitors, the sum of times obtained in GS by two persons from the closest family, previously registered for this competition, counts.

Awards:

In each event in the following categories:

- a. For the top 3 competitors in each age group,
- b. For the 3 best women and men overall (They will not be classified and awarded in age groups).
- c. For the top 3 family teams.
- d. For the oldest and the youngest participant of the competition

Judging panel, Protests:

- 1. The correct course of the competition will be ensured by the judges:
 - Chief Judge Józef Guzik and Judges: Krzysztof Staszel, Joe Keen.
- 2. Protests regarding the competition should be submitted in writing to the competition office within 30 minutes from the end of the descent by the last competitor.
- 3. Interpretation of the regulations belongs to the competition organizers.
- 4. The organizer reserves the right to change the regulations and program of the competition.
